- Since 1968 to 2012 LCIF has awarded more than 11,000 grants, bringing the total amount to over US\$ 811 million.
- Named the Number 1 non-governmental organization in the **world**



How Does LCIF Help?

- Helps Lions respond to major humanitarian concerns
- Enables Lions-to-help-Lions...especially in times of disaster and catastrophe
- Funds projects too big for districts/clubs
- Develops grant-making initiatives to help Lions better serve

Why should Lions Support LCIF?

- We are changing the world
- Grassroots presence = quick response
- We are saving the sight of 30 million people
- Giving measles vaccinations to 157 million children
- Giving disaster relief to 5 million people annually
- Teaching life skills to 12 million youth



Contribute to LCIF?

Effective: - Every dollar donated goes to projects

- Administrative expenses paid from interest income

Efficient: - Administrative expenses less than 11%

Leverage: - Grants typically matched with local funding

<u>Need</u>: - Grants often exceed donations

One Shot, One Life: Lions Measles Initiative

- Joined Measles Initiative in 2010
 - Vaccinated 41 million children in 2010-2011 with partners
 - Lions locally assisted with promotion, outreach and organizing
- Gates Foundation Challenge Grant:
 - The Gates Foundation gives US\$1 for every US\$2 from Lions, up to US\$5 million
 - Lions and the Gates Foundation will provide a total of US\$15 million

One Shot, One Life: Continuation 2012-2013



- As of August 27, LCIF has raised US\$7.25 million
- Need your help to complete the second half of Lions commitment
- Vaccination campaigns taking place in the next few months that need our immediate assistance
- Help us save 157 million children this year

One Shot, One Life: Lions Measles Initiative

- 450 children die daily
- Measles can cause severe complications, including brain damage, hearing loss and blindness
- Can be prevented through a safe and inexpensive vaccination
- Costs less than US\$1
- Leading cause of vaccinepreventable deaths





Grant Programs

Standard Grants

- Initiates/expands Lions humanitarian projects
- The Most common grant -Matching funds up to US\$ 75,000
- Example mobile health units, medical/eye clinics, etc.

SightFirst Grants

• Fight preventable/reversible blindness with sustainable eye care service projects.

Give Sight

SightFirst is the flagship blindness prevention program of LCIF

- Awarded 1,051 grants totaling US\$274 million to 102 countries
- SightFirst has:
 - Saved the sight of more than 27 million people
 - Prevented vision loss for more than 30 million people
 - Improved eye-care services for hundreds of millions



Provide Disaster Relief

Provides emergency aid, such as water, food, shelter and first aid

- Response to Past Disasters:
 - Japan earthquake and tsunami
 - Hurricane Katrina
 - Sichuan (China) Earthquake
 - Haiti Earthquake
 - Superstorm Sandy





Grant Programs

Core 4 Grants

- Up to US\$ 200,000 to target 4 areas:
 - Preserving sight
 - Combating disability
 - Promoting health
 - Serving youth
- LCIF provides either 25% or 75% of cost.



Grant Programs

Emergency Grants

- Up to US\$10,000 for natural disaster relief (tornadoes, floods, hurricanes, etc.)
- Must affect 100+ people
- For immediate needs: food, water, clothing
- More than US\$ 2 million yearly awarded in emergency grants



Criteria for a Grant Application

- Addresses a humanitarian need
- Serves a large population
- Cost effective
- Beyond local Club fund-raising capability
- Strong Lions' identity/involvement
- Endorsed by district cabinet

Impact of Contributions

Contributing Member (US\$ 20)

Treat 20 people for river blindness

Silver Contributing Member (US\$ 50)


Cataract surgery for 2 blind people in Vietnam

Gold Contributing Member (US\$ 100)

- Improve vision in 1,000 children by distributing recycled eyeglasses
- Melvin Jones Fellow (US\$ 1000)
- Train 2 eye doctors in developing countries to do cataract surgery
